Class Video:

English:

Maths:

We will be using White Rose resources to support our learning in maths. For each session, there will be a video, and a worksheet to complete. Remember to pause and re-watch the video as many times as you need to so that you understand what you need to do.

If you are able to print the worksheet, use the 'write on' version - this has WO in the file name, If you are not able to print, use the display version (the file name has a D in it) to look at on the screen, then record your answers on a separate sheet.

Find the 'Elizabeth I' document. Look at the portrait of Elizabeth I. Add what you have found out to your 'Rectangles Sheet' which you started yesterday. You could just describe the portrait, or, to challenge yourself, you could imagine you are actually in the room, meeting Queen Elizabeth I for the first time. What extra details might you notice? Remember to make your account flattering - you wouldn't want a Tudor-style punishment if Elizabeth didn't like what she read!

Your description should be at least four paragraphs long. Remember to make him seem grand, handsome and powerful. If the king were displeased, you could have lost your head in Tudor times!
