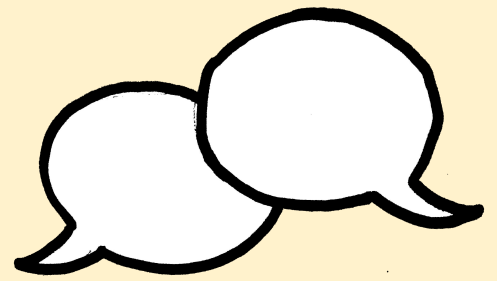

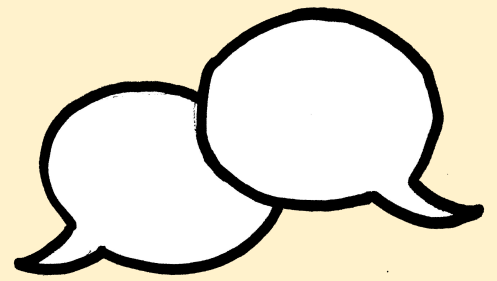
## Individual Thinking

*During Darwin's lifetime, there was fierce opposition to his theory.*

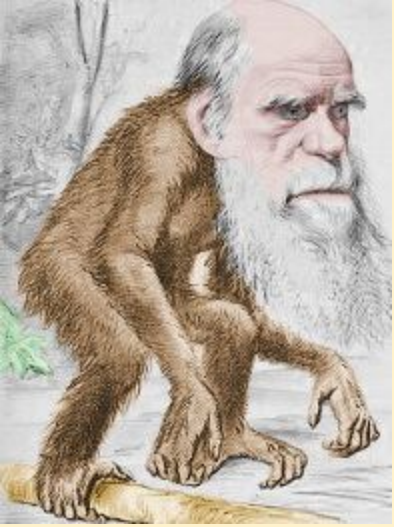

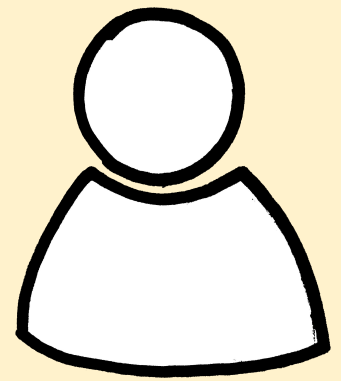
