Pupil Premium Funding – are you eligible?

We receive a sum of money for every child who is entitled to free

school meals (or would be if the meals were not provided free of charge to all children in reception and key stage 1). This money is used by the school for the benefit of your child(ren), through funding areas such as additional training for our staff, reduction of class sizes, investing in partnership working with our colleagues in the area to further our expertise, and supporting our staff in working on specialised areas such as speech and language. If there are any changes in your circumstances, please notify the office and Kelly will take you through the procedures to apply for the premium.
