When?

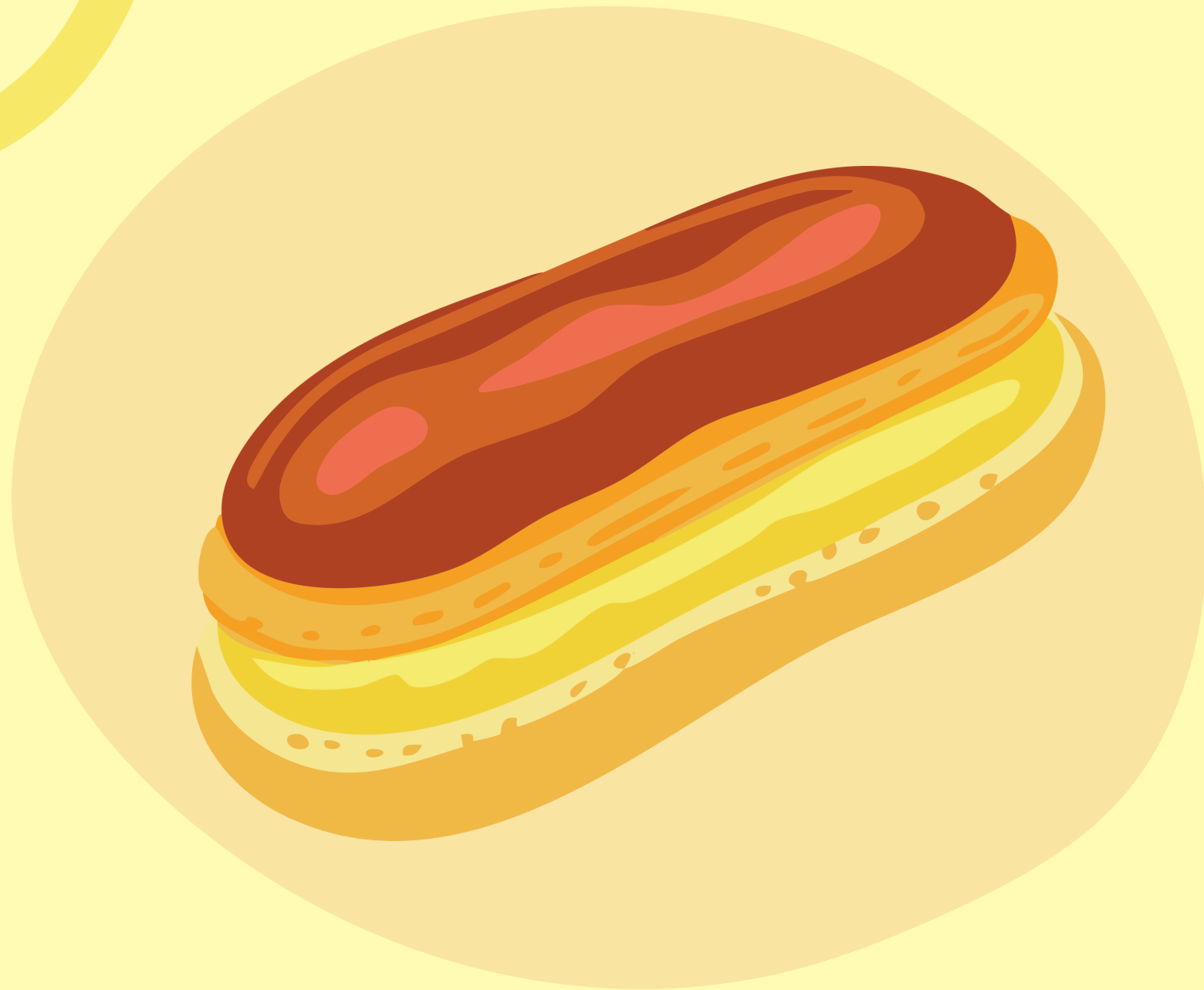



Monday 11th May

All bakes will be sold at the end of the day.

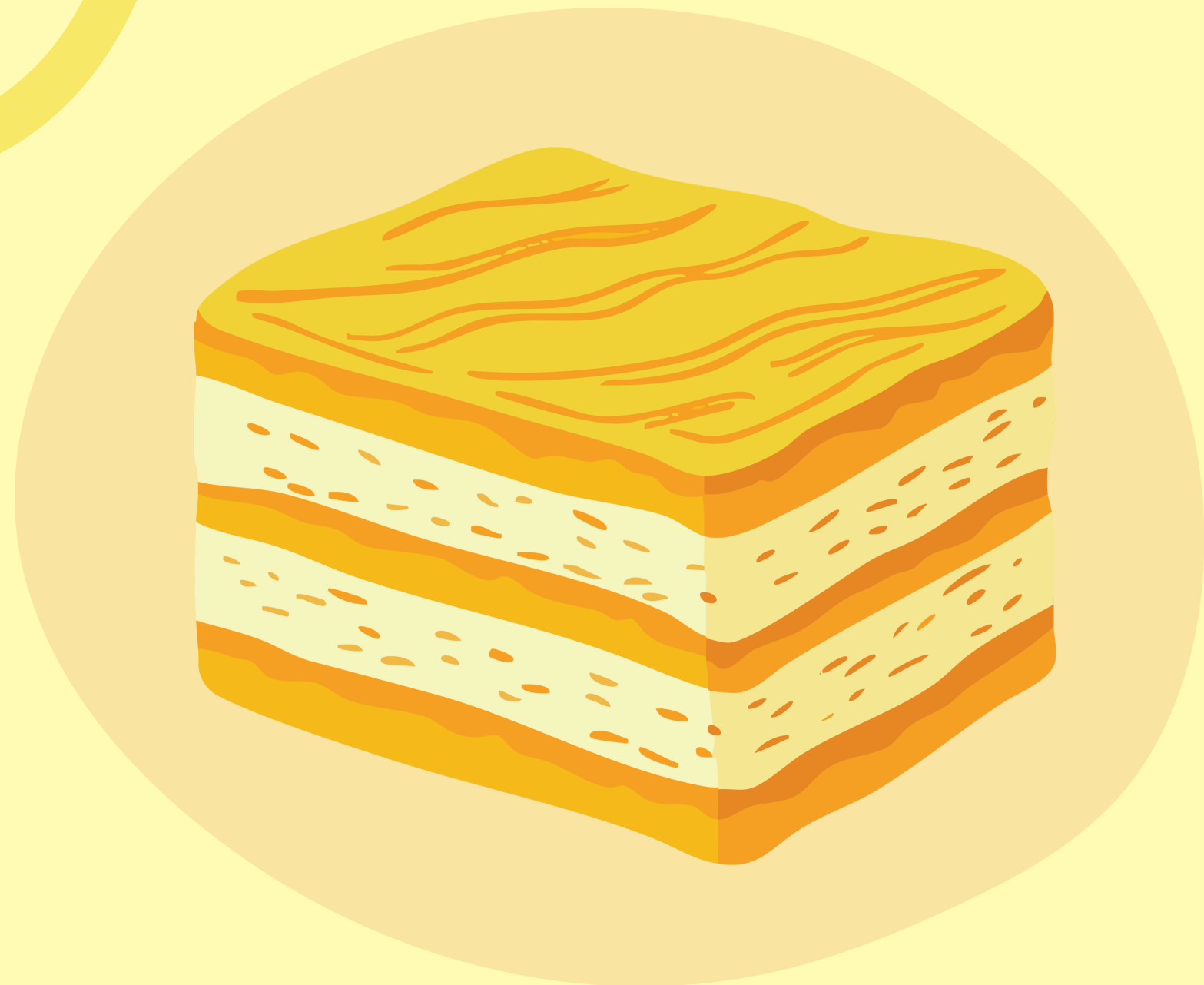


Who can enter?
