How to start a conversation with your child about online safety? Tip 5: Restricting IN-APP purchases

You can restrict your child's ability to make in-app purchases. On an ios device, open Settings, tap General and then Restrictions. Tap 'Enable Restrictions'. You can put a limitation that requires a password every time there is a purchase made in the App Store of iTunes Store
