Ancient Games

- 1. Winners receive palm branches and olive wreaths. There is only one winner for each event.
- 2. Women are not allowed to compete in the Games.
- 3. Males and unmarried women are allowed to spectate at the Games.
- **4.** Athletes don't wear any clothes to compete. They are completely naked.
- 5. The Games are held in honour of the Greek God, Zeus.

Modern Games

- 1. Winners receive a gold medal. There is a silver medal for second place and a bronze medal for third place.
- 2. Male and female competitors from around the world take in part the Games.
- **3.** Billions of people around the world watch the Olympics. They see the Games in person or watch them at home on television or online.
- **4.** There are five coloured rings on the Olympic flag. The rings represent Africa, Asia, Australia, Europe and the Americas.
